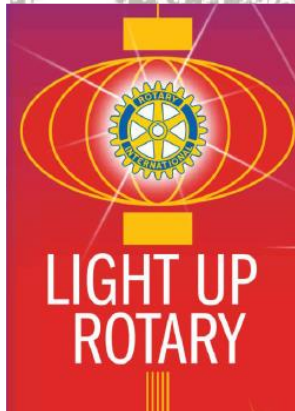

The Australian eChallenge: University of Adelaide's approach to developing entrepreneurial behaviour

Dr Gary Hancock, lecturer and Academic
Director Undergraduate programs, ECIC,
The University of Adelaide will introduce the Australian
eChallenge run by the University of Adelaide and discuss its

impacts and influence on entrepreneurial behaviour. The discussion will include an overview of its recent rapid expansion to include high schools, corporate business, regional Australia, and internationally. The Australian eChallenge is the most successful program of its type in Australia and has been recognised internationally for its effectiveness on both its educational and practical impact.

Gary is a lecturer and the director of undergraduate programs, (including the Bachelor of Innovation and Entrepreneurship program) in the Entrepreneurship, Commercialisation and Innovation Centre (ECIC) at The University of Adelaide, and is involved in the e-Challenge competition, Commercialisation Accelerator Program, and ThinkLab, the University's business incubator.

He has previously taught Small Business Management, Entrepreneurship, and New Venture Creation for the University of South Australia and has developed and delivered on-line entrepreneurship courses for the ATN Group of universities.

In addition, Gary has started and harvested a number of small businesses and consulted to a number of companies in the entertainment, telecommunications, transport, and child-care industries.

Gary provides mentor support and advice to young entrepreneurs via the South Australian Young Entrepreneur Scheme (SAYES), is the past President and Chair of the Board of the WEA and has taught business start-up courses for the WEA and Business SA (the South Australian Chamber of Commerce) for many years.
