**Proposal for training models for clubfoot project in Myanmar**

**Rotary Club of Norwood**

**July 2015**

Walk for life now has five clubfoot clinics in Myanmar. Two clinics, Yangon and Mandalay, are the busiest clinics and have a training program for doctors to learn the Ponseti technique of clubfoot treatment. Both are government teaching hospitals. Currently they have minimal training materials, consisting of training booklets and posters. A proposal for the purchase of three sets of training models, one for each hospital and one set for shared use between the 3 other clinics. These models are of high quality and should last a number of years. These models are also very effective in demonstration and practical training to learn the Ponseti method.

Each set consists of:

1 bone model of clubfoot	\$424.66
1 set of four rubber legs	\$424.66
<u>1 tenotomy model</u>	<u>\$209.59</u>
subtotal	\$1058.91
3 sets will total	\$3176.73 AUD
