Project: Testing a questionnaire about health information

Researchers from the International Centre for Allied Health Evidence at the University of South Australia are developing a questionnaire to find out where people go for health-related information and what they understand about how their own health information is collected and used.

We are looking for people (aged 18 years and over) to test the questionnaire.

This will involve:

- completing the questionnaire (which will take about 10 minutes)
- thinking about the questions that are asked and the way they are presented
- giving us feedback in a telephone interview (which will take about 10-15 minutes).
