## Rotary International Convention Report - Atlanta 2017



Euan introduced the first of our speakers for the evening. Rodger and Glenda Hedley had helpfully arranged some slides of the Convention for us to view.

Amongst the topics Glenda briefly spoke on was the fact that this convention celebrated the Centenary of The Rotary Foundation. Of particular interest was the information that the very first Rotary project was the provision of Public Toilets in Chicago for men.

She also spoke about meeting and sharing time with Rama a former Youth Exchange Student and the inaugural President of the Adelaide University Rotaract Club.

The next Convention will be in Toronto in June 2018. Gail Casey then spoke briefly about some of the speakers who has influenced and inspired her. She spoke particularly about the emphasis of raising \$1.2 billion dollars to end polio. Bill Gates will provide \$450 million if Rotary can raise \$150 million. Gail also spoke of the emphasis to end slavery.
