DISTRICT 9510 REDISTRICTING

Rotary has made the decision to reduce the number of Districts worldwide from 545 to 350. Our Club currently is in District 9520. A new District 9510 will now be created and include our District 9520 and District 9500.

A Steering Committee has been formed to oversee this activity. The role of the committee is to consult, plan, develop and implement a framework for the creation of the new District 9510. The Rotary Club of Norwood has put in an application for a District grant to fund educational resources for the Clarke Special School, which is a special preschool to higher secondary school in Chennai India. The curriculum at the school is tailored to meet the specific needs of children with different disabilities including hearing impaired and deaf-blindness. It is also proposed to establish a 'sister' special school in Adelaide.

We will let you know if this grant is successful. If we are not successful we will need to consider what other funding sources we may be able to access.
